



Sakata Garbage Disposal Rules Calendar

Rules in disposing household wastes and recyclables

Basic rules in disposing wastes/recyclables

- 1 Dispose garbage at the garbage station on the collection day **by 8:am.**
- 2 Follow the **garbage segregation rules** and dispose.
- 3 Use the **designated garbage bag** and dispose.
- 4 Tie the opening of the garbage bag with a **string**.
- 5 Dispose **2 bags** of burnable garbage per household, and **1 bag** of recyclables, PET bottles, landfill waste, and mercury waste (fluorescent tubes and batteries are disposed separately).
- 6 Dispose your waste at the **specified garbage station managed by the community association in your area**.
- 7 Business-related garbage from **shops and business establishments** are not allowed to be disposed at the garbage station and Recycle Resource Collection Facility.



Priority Goals of Waste Reduction Strategy

- Dispose miscellaneous waste as recyclables.
- Raw food waste must be "well drained", "dry".

Please use the Recycle Resource Collection Facility.

Acceptable items

◆Papers(newspapers, magazines, cardboards, miscellaneous items, paper cartons.)

◆ Miyanoura (Miyanoura Community Disaster Prevention center) (Excluding bottles)	Monday to Friday 2nd and 4th Sunday	9am to 4pm 9am to 12pm	12/29~1/3 (Closed)

Oversized garbage / Large quantities of household waste / Small Rechargeable battery-powered devices(fee required)

Any item with a side measuring more than 20cm is classified as oversized garbage, including small rechargeable battery-powered products. Disposing large volume waste at one time is considered as large amount of garbage. Small rechargeable battery-powered products are generally collected by their manufacturers. If they cannot be accepted due to battery swelling or other reasons, or if the manufacture is unknown, they may be taken to a recycling center.

Door-to-door collection: Reservation is required.

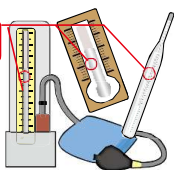

Mercurial Thermometers(sphygmomanometer, thermometer)

How to identify the mercury part

The **silver** part indicating blood pressure temperature, and body temperature in a glass tube is the mercury.



Place

- Collection BOX (in front of the Citizen's Section on the 1st floor of the city hall)
- Collection BOX (Environmental Health Division)
- All areas - branches has its own general Collection BOX

Cannot be disposed at the garbage station.

Burnable Garbage/Used Cooking Oil Disposal

Raw food waste
Drain the water well

CDs, videotapes, Plastics

Disposable body warmer

Vinyls, rubbers, leather products, clothes

Used paper
Excluding recyclable paper

Metal caps and lids of beverages, etc.
Up to 5cm

Pruned branches
Cut branches not thicker than 3cm and not longer than 1m. Make a bundle of about 30 cm. (Up to 2 bundles at a time)

Styrofoam
Dispose up to 2 large items at a time
(Use of bag is optional)

Disposable diapers
Flush body wastes before disposal

How to dispose used cooking oil
① Filter the used cooking oil to remove impurities.
② Put it in a PET bottle (up to 2L) and close the lid tightly.

For PET bottles only

① Remove the cap and label

② Rinse the inside

③ Crush and put in a designated plastic bag

If caps and labels, cooking oil containers, and items that are hard to clean, dispose these as burnable waste.

Containers of shochu, sweet sake, soy sauce, vinegar, seasonings, soft drinks

Hazardous Waste (Garbage containing mercury)

Put fluorescent tubes and batteries separately in a transparent bag and dispose at the garbage station on the day when **水銀** is written.

LED bulbs and incandescent bulbs

Fluorescent tubes only
Dispose the broken items in a separate bag. Long items sticking out of the bag is allowed.

Batteries only
Cover the positive and negative electrodes of button batteries.

Recyclables (Paper waste)

Sort out papers by item and tie them with a string.

- Dispose paper wastes on the collection day of recyclables.
- Deposit at the Recycle Resource Collection Facility.
- Submit to the garbage station specified by the residents' association in the area where you reside.

Newspapers / Flyers

Miscellaneous waste
Remove all vinyls and put the paper in a paper bag. Tie it with a string.

Magazines
(Including books, catalogs, pamphlets and notebooks)

Paper cartons
Exclude those coated with aluminum and those less than 500ml

Cardboards
Remove adhesive tapes and delivery slips.

Confectionery boxes / Tissue boxes

Toilet paper cores / Wrap cores

Calendars / Wrapping paper

Dirty and odorous items
 ✗ Waterproof paper
 ✗ Photos
 ✗ Stickers
 ✗ Adhesive memos
 ✗ Crimping postcards
 ✗ Carbonless copy paper
 ✗ Receipts

Recyclables

Various types of bottles of soft drinks, energy drinks, seasonings, liquor, cosmetics, etc.

Metal caps and lids (up to 5cm in size) should be removed from the bottles and disposed as burnable waste.

※If you want to return 1.8 liter bottles or beer bottles, please contact the store/distributor at which you purchased the items.

Steel cans / Aluminum cans

Toasters, Electric kettles, Metal toys

Spray cans / Gas cartridges
Empty the container

Metalic /enameled kitchenwares such as pots and frying pans etc.

Degassing indoors or by drilling holes is extremely dangerous. Please degas safely by following the methods described on the container.

Landfill Waste

LED bulbs / Incandescent bulbs

Blades such as glass, mirrors, knives, etc.
Wrap broken and sharp items such as glass and blades in paper and dispose them safely.

Ceramics such as bowls, plates and vases

Clothes irons / Cameras

Umbrellas
Please dispose vinyl part as (Burnable garbage) and the metal part as (Recyclables)

Small amount (about 1/3 of the bag) of soil / sand / ashes

Glass lined Thermos

Rechargeable batteries used in mobile phones and digital cameras are classified as valuable resources. Please contact your dealer / manufacturer directly for collection.
